Joins Bar Soap Recycling Program Run by Clean the World® Sends three boxes of used soap to recycling facility with first collection

BELLUSTAR TOKYO, A Pan Pacific Hotel (Shinjuku-ku, Tokyo; General Manager: Katsushi Nishikawa) has joined the Global Hospitality Recycling Program run by Clean the World® that collects bar soap used by hotel guests for recycling. The first collection of used soap from the hotel took place on 31 March 2025.

Clean the World® is a social enterprise established in the United States. Its Global Hospitality Recycling Program collects bar soap that would normally be disposed of by the world's hospitality industry, recycles them into new bars and other hygiene products and donates them to vulnerable communities to help improve hygiene conditions. BELLUSTAR TOKYO, A Pan Pacific Hotel, is a participant in the Clean the World Asia program. Since 2014, this program has partnered with 89 hotels in Japan, Hong Kong,

Macau, Singapore and Taiwan to recycle more than 537 t of bar soap and distribute more than four million bars of recycled soap and other hygiene products to charitable organizations across Asia.

For the first collection from BELLUSTAR TOKYO, A Pan Pacific Hotel, on Monday, 31 March 2025, three boxes of leftover bar soap used by hotel guests that would previously have been disposed of were sent to the program's Hong Kong recycling facility to be reborn into new bar soap.

To date, BELLUSTAR TOKYO, A Pan Pacific Hotel, has promoted various initiatives to become an eco-friendly hotel in line with the SDGs. These include the introduction of the BEAUTYCYCLE recycling system that has achieved bottle-to-bottle recycling for bath amenities in

its guest rooms, and the planning and sale of products that upcycled cherry tree blossoms and branches used to decorate the hotel's interior.

Through its participation in this hospitality recycling program, BELLUSTAR TOKYO, A Pan Pacific Hotel, will continue to contribute to making society sustainable through its hotel business and achieve Tokyu Hotels' goals to make its properties friendly to the earth, local communities and people.
